AFSA AWARD CATEGORIES

MAN OF THE YEAR:

WOMAN OF THE YEAR:

Nomination for a woman serving in a FRS who has done outstanding and exceptional work in promoting the values of the FRS.

AWARDS FOR OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTION TO CHARITABLE ACTIVITY:

A person(s) who may or may not be employed by the FRS, who has done exceptional work for a charity.

AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING ENDEAVOUR BY AN AFSA MEMBER:

A regional AFSA member that has been exceptional in the way they have supported the AFSA objectives.

AWARD FOR CHAMPION OF EQUALITY AND DIVERSITY:

A person(s) who may or may not be employed in the FRS, who has done exceptional work in promoting inclusion, equality and diversity.

AWARD FOR LEADERSHIP IN EQUALITY AND DIVERSITY:

A person(s) who may or may not be employed in the FRS, who has done exceptional work in leading on in equality, diversity and Inclusion.

AWARD FOR POSITIVE ACTION:

An individual who has over the last 12 months undertaken innovative practices to attract or develop staff from diverse communities.

AWARD FOR ADDRESSING HEALTH INEQUALITIES IN THE COMMUNITY:

An individual who has developed a project that has empowered staff to address health inequalities in partnership with other agencies.
